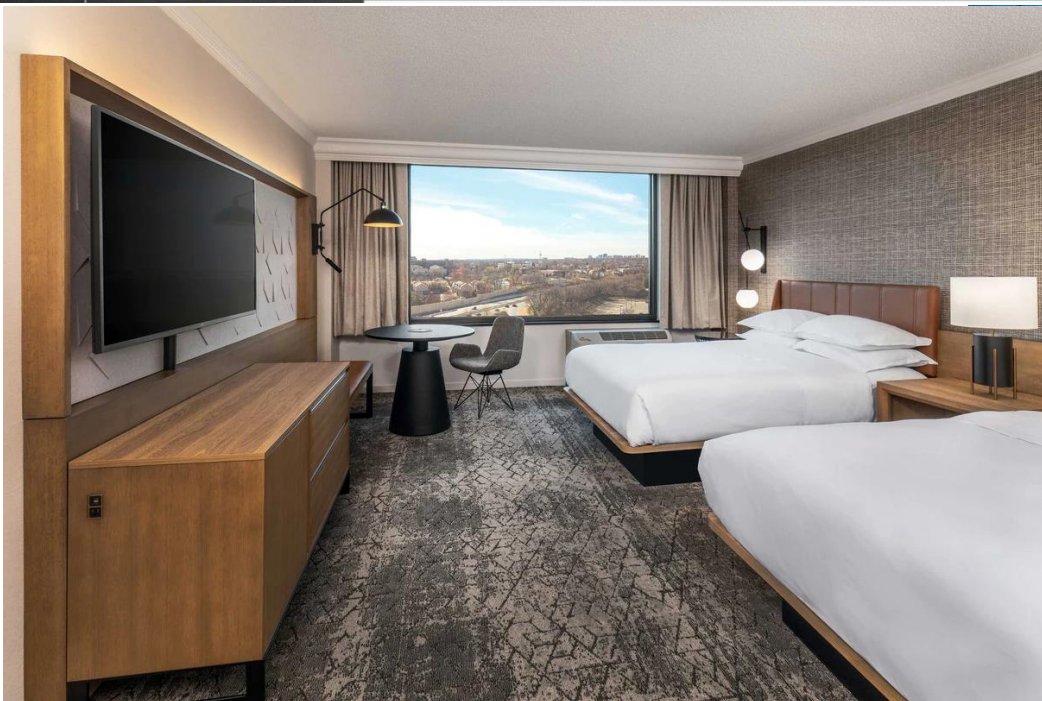

# Trip Cost:

- The full cost of the trip is \$1,015 per student based on quad hotel room occupancy. (The price for chaperones will be higher if a single, double, or triple occupancy room is chosen).
- Parents can purchase trip insurance if desired
- Chaperone Support: Parents are welcome to join the trip as chaperones. Chaperones will be chosen closer to the trip based on the needs of the band and previous chaperone experience.
- Each parent who wishes to chaperone must pay the full cost of the trip.
  - Note: The cost for chaperones may be a bit more than the base cost depending on the room type chosen since the base cost is based on 4 people in a room.

- Base Cost (4 per room): \$1,015
- Triple Occupancy Cost: \$1,082

- Double Occupancy Cost: \$1,217
- Single Occupancy Cost: \$1,623





# Scholarships Available:

- The band boosters want to make this trip available for all band students regardless of ability to pay.
- We anticipate that some band families will be able to pay the full cost of the trip while some families may need a partial or full scholarship.
- Each band student will be required to complete a commitment form, letting us know if you are able to pay or if you need to request a partial or full scholarship.
- **This form must be returned by Friday, September 16 by all parents to help us account for every band student**

## 2023 PLD Band Washington DC Trip Commitment Form

The PLD Band will be traveling to Washington, DC April 19-23, 2023. This trip will involve performing as a band as well as sightseeing in DC. For school purposes, this will be an official field trip. More information about the trip can be [found here](#).

The band boosters want to make this trip available for all band students regardless of ability to pay. That said, this trip involves significant expenses. We'll need families who can contribute to the cost of the trip to do so and we'll need to do some special fundraising in order to cover the band's overhead costs for the trip. We believe this will be a special experience of making memories for our band students!

The full cost of the trip is \$1,015 per student based on quad hotel room occupancy. (The price for chaperones will be higher if a single, double, or triple occupancy room is chosen). This includes hotel, food, entrance fees, and transportation. It does not include extra spending or souvenir money. Parents are able to go on the trip as chaperones, but will be required to pay the full cost of the trip. Scholarships will only be provided to band students who need and request financial assistance.
